

The C-BRTA Cookies Policy

The Cross-Border Road Transport Agency (“we”/“us”) is committed to protecting and respecting any personal information you share with us.

1. What is a Cookie?

- 1.1. A “cookie” is a small text file that is stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website, and which allows a website to recognise your device and remember if you visited the website before.
- 1.2. Cookies are used to measure which parts of the website people visit and to customise the web browsing experience.

2. Our Cookies

- 2.1. We use cookies to enhance the performance of our website and personalise the C-BRTA website browsing experience.
- 2.2. Cookies help us to collect information on how people use and interact with the C-BRTA website. Cookies enable us to monitor visitor numbers and analyse website usage patterns and trends.
- 2.3. The C-BRTA website cookie information is collected anonymously, and does not store any individual or personal information.
- 2.4. Internet browsers allow users to refuse to accept cookies and to remove current cookies. When blocking certain cookies, this may have a negative impact upon the usability of the C-BRTA website.

3. C-BRTA’s Web Site Cookie List
