1. Introduction to C-BRTA

The Cross-Border Road Transport Agency (C-BRTA) is PFMA Schedule 3A Agency established through the Cross-Border Road Transport Act 4 of 1998 and provides advice, regulation, facilitation and law enforcement in respect of commercial cross border road transportation. The Act gives the C-BRTA mandate to licence commercial cross border road transport operators by issuing permits to operate. The provision of cross-border transport services in South Africa is subject to the provisions of the Cross-Border Road Transport Act. In terms of the Act, any person or organisation wishing to provide cross-border transport services must apply to the Cross-Border Road Transport Agency's Regulatory Committee for a Permit to conduct cross-border business.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Background

The C-BRTA went through an organizational re-design process which gave rise to new positions being created in the new structure. The HR unit is on a drive to fill the vacancies which are at different levels. Candidates who qualify for positions at Middle Management, Senior Management and Executive level will have to go for competency and psychometric assessments through a services provider.

2. Objective of the project

The competency and psychometric assessment seek to assist the panel members in determining the competency levels of the interviewed candidates and considered for the roles. It is requested that a service provider be sourced for period of 24 months contract as this is an on-going process to fill vacancies as and when required.

3. The Scope of Work is as follows:
